MAJORS

Communication is the process of transmitting information and understanding to another person or group of people. A bachelor's degree in Communication provides a foundation of knowledge of this process and as well as specific skills that are useful in most employment settings. UNM"s Department of Communication & Journalism offers Bachelor of Arts degrees in both Communication with concentrations in interpersonal, intercultural, organizational, public, and environmental communication and media studies. A degree in Communication serves as excellent preparation for careers in fields such as sales, public relations, organizational communication, training, and management.

Although many entry-level careers are available to those with a Bachelor's degree in Communication, Communication majors often choose to continue their education in disciplines such as business, education, public administration, and law.

Graduate School

Admittance into graduate schools typically requires completed pre-requisites, passing of an entrance exam such as the GRE, and a competitive GPA. Admission requirements vary based on the program.

- Government: public information, legislative assistance, research, social services, community affairs, program administration


