

## **Tips**



- In addition to developing technical skills, it is encouraged for film and digital arts students to create a portfolio or "demo reel" that grows throughout their undergraduate studies. Both hard copy and digital portfolios can be useful tools to procure potential internships and jobs.
- Your capstone project is a great opportunity to develop your portfolio. If your portfolio or "demo reel" doesn't seem to highlight your best skills, then create what is called spec work or "fake" projects that you specifically produce to show off particular skills to potential studios or clients.
