

CAREERS FOR MUSIC – Theory & Composition MAJORS

The study of music and music's effects on individuals, communities, and cultures is a fascinating and complex endeavor. <u>UNM's College of Fine Arts</u> allows students to delve into the intellectual, theoretical, and historical study of the art of music. Students are encouraged to <u>speak with a College of Fine Arts academic advisor</u> to discuss the requirements for each degree.

Bachelor of Music in Theory and Composition

Students in this program will hear, analyze, and theorize music from the sixteenth century to modern day. Students will also write and receive critiques on their own musical compositions. The Bachelor of Music in Theory and Composition is designed to prepare students for graduate work.

Bachelor of Arts in Music

This program earns a non-performance music degree and is designed for students who are interested in studying multiple aspects of musicianship. This degree is popular amongst students who wish to double major or take course work to prepare for a pre-professional program. Students can also seek alternative teaching licensure and go into K-12 education.




Tips
