The BM degree is a pre-professional degree that allows students to hone their craft in pursuit of a career as a music performer. Students can pick their chosen instrument or voice and must audition for admittance to the program. Students have many career options after graduation stemming from becoming a professional musician to a music director or composer. Art Therapy and teaching can also be appealing, although additional education or teaching licensure is required.


