UNM's Secondary Education Program prepares students to teach grades 7-12 in public or private schools. These teachers are commonly known as middle school and high school teachers. Middle school and high school teachers will teach students in one or more subjects.

<u>UNM's Secondary Education Program</u> offers teaching concentrations in these subjects:

- Earth Science
- French
- German
- Language Arts
- Life Science

- Mathematics
- Physical Science w/ Chemistry
- Physical Sciences w/ Physics
- Social Studies
- Spanish

Licensure is required in most states and will vary from state to state. <u>New Mexico's</u> Licensure Requirements for Secondary Education (7-12).

In April 2019, Governor Michelle Lujan signed a bill that allowed a 6% raise for all public school staff. Some teachers stand to gain even more as minimum pay grades rise to \$41,000 for new educators, and to \$50,000 and \$60,000 for higher certification levels.

Industries & Target Employers

- Education: Public or private secondary school teacher. Licensure will allow individuals to teach 7-12
- Childcare: Independently owned businesses, corporate childcare services, military childcare, religious organizations, daycare centers, etc.
- Community Services: Not for profit, YMCA, YWCA, Camp programs, Residential Treatment Facilities, Rehabilitation programs, workforce programs, specialty group programs, adoption agencies, etc.
- Continuing/Certificate Programs: GED programs, Adult Education, Continuing Education programs, Board of Education, community colleges, professional associations, specialty populations
- Government: Research, Federal, state or city government, teaching, evaluation
- Social Services: Residential treatment facilities, youth services, senior services, Welfare and Health Departments, case management
- Business: HR, Corporations, Marketing, Test-taking companies, publishers, sales, customer service organizations, not for profit organization, Training and Development, consultation, etc.
