#### MAJORS

For some people, creativity is cultivated through one of humanities most cherished art forms – theatre. There are a multitude of people who call this great stage home – actors, directors, playwrights, dancers, costumers, and designers who strive to produce moments of enchantment for their audience to remember. <u>UNM's Department of Theatre and Dance</u> offers students the opportunity to hone their craft by learning from a diverse pool of faculty and students. The Department of Theatre and Dance also encourages cross discipline collaboration and offers two incredible performance spaces in <u>Rodey Theatre and The X – Experimental Theatre</u>. There are three different undergraduate degrees within the Department of Theatre and Dance and students are encouraged to <u>speak with a College of Fine Arts academic advisor</u>.

#### Bachelor of Arts in Theatre

Students are able to explore all elements of theatre including theory and technique. Exploration and experimentation are nurtured within the program and students will refine skills in acting, directing, design, dance, playwriting, and production.

### Bachelor of Arts in Dance

There are two concentration areas for a BA in Dance – Contemporary Dance and Flamenco. Students within the program are encouraged to participate in UNM's Annual Flamenco Festival. Albuquerque is home to the National Institute of Flamenco and <u>Festival Flamenco Albuquerque</u> which hosts world renowned artists each summer. Dance majors must audition for admittance into the program.

#### Bachelor of Fine Arts in Design Technology for Performance

A hands-on degree for students interested in costume, lighting, and scenic design. Students will be able to practice in UNM's state-of-the-art training facilities under the guidance of experienced faculty and staff.
